




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► PRAYER

¹⁵ For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" ¹⁶ The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ¹⁷ and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

How are we to hold a sword while rebuilding the wall?
"...From His mouth came a sharp two-edged sword..." Revelation 1:16

Definitive declarations moved in the Spirit world had almost immediate push-back.

We hold our swords in our mouths at all times! Therefore, in order to build a wall while standing guard against the enemy, we must be ready to "give account" of the truth" 1 Peter 3:15.

Sonship and Authority 101:

"God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it..." **Genesis 1:28**

<u>"Subdue"</u> – Hebrew word, "kavash", literally means to place your foot on the neck of your conquered enemy, signifying a submission of the enemy to his defeater. A similar word, "malak", means to have dominion over or to rule over.

From the very beginning, we were to have **Sonship Authority**.

■ GUIDE QUESTIONS

(NUMBERED ACCORDING TO LEVEL OF DEPTH AND READINESS TO SHARE)

- 1. On a scale from 1-10 (1 = none at all; 10 = extreme), how would you rate your heart to serve others? Why have you rated yourself this way?
- 2. In Romans 8:15-17, Paul writes about no longer being slaves, but that we have been adopted by Jesus as his sons and daughters who can cry out "Abba, Father". What do you think this might mean? What does this mean for you personally in your life?
- 3. Read also Galatians 4:4-7. What do you think might be some differences between SERVANTS who serve and SONS who serve? Which do you think God himself prefers?
- 4. Nehemiah and his men gave their first to God as an offering, reflecting their worship and trust in God. When you first receive your wage or salary, do you find it a chore to give, or do you see an opportunity to worship God with your finances?

If you are not yet a follower of Jesus, would you choose today to trust him? Will you enable him to have all authority as the one who calls the shots in your life? Would you like to enter into a saving relationship with God through Jesus?

Ask your Life Group leader to lead you in prayer to receive Christ. You can pray this prayer:

Dear Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner, and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe you died for my sins and rose from the dead. I turn from my sins and invite you to be the master of my life.
