DISCUSSION QUESTIONS ((NUMBERED ACCORDING TO LEVEL OF DEPTH AND READINESS TO SHARE))

1. On a scale from 1 to 10 (1 being never and 10 being always), how confident do you feel in your ability to assist someone in need? What would determine your level of assistance?

2. What do we know about Zacchaeus from the passage? (v1-3)

3. How would you describe yourself and your relationship with Jesus?

4. How can we connect with Jesus on a daily basis to foster a deeper relationship with Him?

5. What sticks out for you about Zacchaeus's character and the decisions that he made? Why does this stick out for you?

6. How does the Gospel message empower your daily life? What changes has the Gospel message done in you?

7. Would you choose today to trust Jesus as the LORD of your life - ruling in all things, including and especially in our finances? Will you enable him to have all authority as the one who calls the shots in your life? Would you like to enter into a saving relationship with God through Jesus? Ask your lifegroup leader to lead you in prayer to receive Christ. You can pray this prayer:

Dear Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. I turn from my sins and invite You to be the master of my life. I want to trust and follow You as my Lord and Saviour. I declare that I am Yours, and You are mine, In Jesus name, AMEN.
