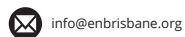
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WORD

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

((NUMBERED ACCORDING TO LEVEL OF DEPTH AND READINESS TO SHARE))

1. On a scale from 1 to 10 (1 being rarely, 10 being extremely regularly) how often have you seen or experienced for yourself a loving union between this person/yourself and God?
2. How would you best describe your relationship with God?
3. How do you respond when God invites you to slow down for loving union? How are we WIRE-D? Discuss these initial responses.
4. Do you recognise when God asks you to slow down to meet with Him? Welcome it with hesitation? Ignore? Resist completely? Enter in?
5. If our lifestyles reflect our worship to God, what activities can help develop a rhythm of creating environments where our relationships develop with Him as individuals, in our families and our communities? Take time to also share what's helped in your daily routines. This may assist along with prayer some of us building an environment to grow/freshen our time with Him.
6. For God so loved the world that He gave. The invitation is here and the choice is ours. If you would choose today to trust Jesus as the LORD of your life - ruling in all things, take this moment to pray with your group. Will you enable him to have all authority as the one who calls the shots in your life? Would you like to enter into a saving relationship with God through Jesus? Ask your lifegroup leader to lead you in prayer to receive Christ. You can pray this prayer:

Dear Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. I turn from my sins and invite You to be the master of my life. I want to trust and follow You as my Lord and Saviour. I declare that I am Yours, and You are mine, In Jesus name, AMEN.
