DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (NUMBERED ACCORDING TO LEVEL OF DEPTH AND READINESS TO SHARE)

1. On a scale from 1 to 10 (1 being very confident and 10 not confident at all), when it comes to proclaiming God's glory among the nations, where would you position yourself on this scale in terms of feeling equipped and motivated to share your faith? Why have you rated yourself this way?

2. What role does gratitude play in your worship, and how do you cultivate a heart of thankfulness in your daily life?

3. Verse 6 mentions the splendor and majesty of God's holiness. How do these attributes inspire awe in your worship, and how can we convey that awe to others.

4. How do you cultivate a heart of joy and gladness when you approach worship, as suggested in verse 9? What practices or attitudes contribute to a joyful worship experience for you?

5. Do you want to trust Jesus as the Ruler and sole source of fulfilment of your life by accepting His call for you to enter into relationship with Him? I want to trust and follow You as my Lord and Saviour. I declare that I am Yours, and You are mine, In Jesus name, AMEN.
