A DISCIPLE of CHRIST:

FOLLOWS JESUS

Vs 19 And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." 20 Immediately they left their nets and followed him.

- to follow Jesus means to HAVE HIM as PRIORITY in your life
- what does this look like in your every day schedule?
- to follow Jesus means to KNOW HIM DEEPER through CONTEMPLATIVE PRAYER based on HiS WORD and a LIFESTYLE of WORSHIP.

FISHES FOR THE LOST

Vs 19 And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."

To fish for the lost, means to help those who don't know Jesus to discover Him through the good news of his Gospel.

Jesus was in their world - the Sea of Galilee

Jesus learnt and spoke their language - they were fishermen, so he said "Fishers of Men"

Jesus carried the message worth leaving everything behind for, because He came from Heaven to fish them out of their "lostness".

FELLOWSHIP with OTHER BELIEVERS

21 And going on from there he saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets, and he called them. 22 Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

Jesus called these men to walk together as a GROUP of disciples.

God's intent was always for us to be a part of Christian community, learning to love one another as we walk and grow together in Him.
