OPENING QUESTION

If you had to choose a theme song to describe finding joy in tough times, what would it be?



(read together as a group)

2 Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, 3 for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. 4 And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. 6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind. 7 For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; 8 he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

12 Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him. 13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one. 14 But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. 15 Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.

16 Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers. 17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change. 18 Of his own will he brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

James 1:2-8, 12-18 (ESV)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (NUMBERED ACCORDING TO LEVEL OF DEPTH AND READINESS TO SHARE)

- 1. Reflect on James 1:2-4, which challenges us to count it all joy when we face trials. Why is it difficult yet essential to find joy in suffering?
- 2. Share personal experiences where you've found unexpected joy or growth through a challenging situation.
- 3. Discuss ways we can intentionally focus on the cross of Christ during times of suffering to rediscover the joy found in His sacrifice for us.
- 4. Reflect on how long-suffering and endurance are essential traits in discipleship. How can we cultivate these qualities in our walk with Christ?
- 5. Share practical ways to maintain faith and joy when faced with prolonged hardships or trials.
- 6. In times of hardship, how can we turn our focus from our circumstances to Jesus, finding strength and peace in Him?
- 7. Pray together for each other to trust Jesus more in the midst of trials and to find joy in His salvation.

If anyone in the group desires to deepen their trust in Jesus or to receive Him as their Lord and Saviour, they can pray this prayer :

"Lord Jesus, in the midst of trials and challenges, I choose to trust You. Help me to count it all joy when I face various trials, knowing that You are with me. I believe that You died on the cross for my sins and rose again, offering me salvation and eternal life. I confess my sins and invite You to be the Lord of my life. Thank You for Your love and grace. In Your name, Amen."
